We have roughly 4 weeks remaining before students in grades 3-8 participate in the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress, or CAASPP. It is imperative that our students are present each day and eager to actively participate in applying the purposeful teaching and learning taking place all over campus.

This is the fourth year that students at Bella Vista will participate in the CAASPP test. Students in grades 3-8 will take computer-based assessments for English/Language Arts and Math. In addition, fifth and eighth grade students will be assessed in science.

Information gained from the end of the year assessments will be analyzed to determine student progress and make instructional decisions and placements for the 2018-2019 school year.

Students will take the state assessments the first two weeks of May. During this testing window, please be sure to support your child/children by having them at school on time each morning and well-rested from the night before. We thank you in advance for your continued support as our students excel during our CAASPP testing!
