Why Get a Flu Shot?

Flu season is officially here! Influenza (The Flu) is a potentially serious disease that can lead to hospitalization or sometimes even death. Symptoms of the flu include fever, muscle aches, chills and sweats, headache, fatigue, cough, sore throat, and congestion. Millions of people get the flu each year and hundreds of thousands of those people are hospitalized. An annual seasonal flu vaccine is the best way to prevent infection. The CDC recommends that all people over the age of 6 months receive the flu vaccine. If your child is between the ages of 6 months and 9 years, and have never received a flu vaccine before, they should get 2 vaccinations, 4 weeks apart. Most insurances cover the cost of the flu shot 100%. Head into your local pharmacy anytime and get your vaccine today!

Child Find

Bella Vista Elementary School District provides for a free and appropriate public education for all children with disabilities in a variety of specially designed programs. Special education and related services are available for persons, ages 3-21 inclusive, who have disabilities in the following areas: autism, deaf-blindness, auditory impairment, intellectual disabilities, multiple disabilities, orthopedic impairment, other health impairment, emotional disability, specific learning disability, speech or language impairment, traumatic brain injury, and visual impairment. Services for students with an auditory or visual impairment may begin at birth. Programs for preschool-aged children with disabilities are also available.
